We run life & employment skills programs for teens & young adults on the Autism Spectrum & with other disabilities

We focus on building independent living skills, community engagement, employment skills, social skills & connection.

We offer both groups & individual 1:1 sessions

Individual 1:1 Life & Employment Skills Sessions (Occupational Therapy)

1:1 sessions with Mira or Amanda offer teens & young adults the opportunity to form a partnership with their therapist & work towards achieving meaningful personalized goals in the areas of independent living, life skills & employment skills.

Common goals: developing employment skills such as resume writing, interview skills, time management & job searching; or working toward independent living by developing social skills & learning about budgeting, cooking, sexuality & relationships, & more!

Details:

Timing: 1:1 sessions are each 50 minutes long and can start at any time

Frequency: Weekly or biweekly (Depends on your goals & availability)

Cost: \$90/session (\$75/session for first 3 months!) Case-by-case sliding scale option
