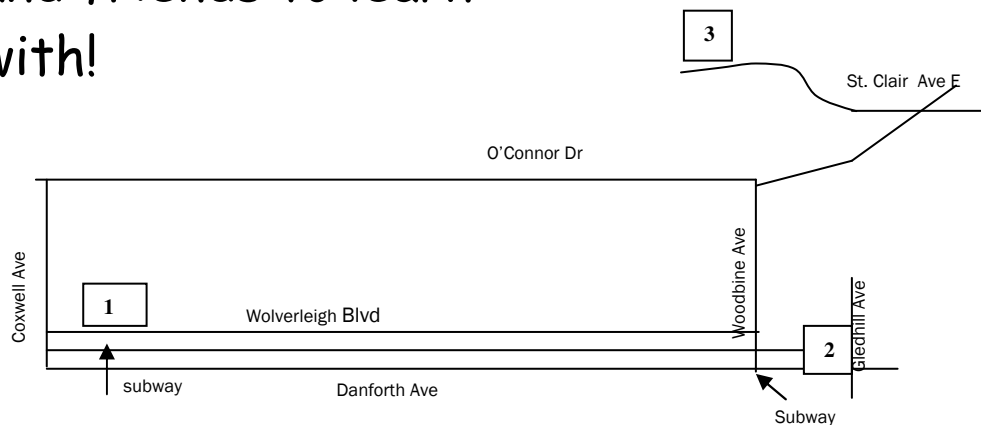
Infants, toddlers and preschoolers will find lots to learn about... and friends to learn with!
